Whatever begins to exist has a cause.

The universe began to exist.

Therefore, the universe has a cause.

TWO LINES OF EVIDENCE SUPPORT A BEGINNING

Philosophy says that there cannot be an infinite number of past moments before reaching this present one. And science shows that the universe began with the Big Bang.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE FIRST CAUSE

This cause would be outside nature (supernatural) and beyond space and time. It's immaterial and super powerful. It would be a personal mind.





BUT WHAT ABOUT NOTHING?

Appealing to "nothing" is truly a bankrupt idea.
You can't pay your bills with nothing in the bank,
and you can't bring a universe into existence
from nothing!

BUT MIND IS POWERFUL

We know from personal experience that mind is powerful. Everything humans create begins first as an idea in the mind. Certainly, the mind of an all-powerful God could speak the universe into being.
