Individuals are not the basis of morality.

Society is not the basis of morality.

Had Adolph Hitler won WWII, gassing Jews would still be wrong. The Allies were right in holding the Nazis to an objective standard of right and wrong above their society.

Science and other options are not the basis of morality.

Science tells us how to build the bomb, not if we should use it. Evolution is about promoting a creature's survival, not cultivating its goodness.





Platitudes are not the basis of morality.

Some say morality is about "human flourishing."
But who decides what contributes to flourishing, as well as which course to take?

Objective moral values and duties do exist.
