Nature is all there is.


THIS MEANS THAT




"FREE WILL"

It Gets Even Weirder... If That's Possible

When people deny that free will exists, they cannot hold this belief freely as a result of rational reflection. Their thoughts are driven by brain chemistry, too.

If their position isn't rational, then why accept it as being true? They may argue that it's rational, but we can dismiss their assertions as being products of their brain chemistry. Weird, isn't it?

The problem with [determinism] is that without freedom, rationality would have no room to operate. Arguments would not matter, since no one would be able to base beliefs on adequate reasons. One could never judge between a good idea and a bad one. One would only hold beliefs because he had been predetermined to do so.

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But what about brain trauma?


Imagine a talented musician playing a song on a piano with broken keys. While the music sounds one way in his head, it sounds completely different to his audience.
